TODAY'S MUSIC

A Choir of Angels The 15th Century Flemish painter, Simon Marmion, was known as the 'prince of illumination', his paintings were so jewel-like. In this panel three angels hover in the air with trumpets, their wings resplendent against the dark sky. Here the trumpet and piano imitate and echo, as if in a large reverberating acoustic, suggestive of the Monteverdi Vespers.

In Memoriam was commissioned in 2000 in memory of Gwen Smith, mother of Philip Smith (principal trumpet of the New York Philharmonic) and wife of Derek Smith. As an inspiration for this composition, the composer was moved by the words from an old hymn by Karl Spitta (1801-1859) "We Are the Lord's".

Trumpet Prelude Johan Roman was a Swedish Baroque composer. He has been called the father of Swedish music or the Swedish Handel. Roman was the deputy master of the Royal Chapel in Stockholm and six years later he became Chief Master of the Swedish Royal Orchestra. This piece shows the influence of the music of G.F. Handel who Roman studied under in his 20's in London.
