

The past couple of weeks have reminded us what winter can mean here in West Michigan. Icy cold temps, wind chills below zero, tons of snow and school closures. As we begin to dig out and our bodies are becoming more accustomed to the weather I want to bring us back inside to warm chores in the house. Yep, laundry is on my mind. Extra warmth and outside snow garments mean more laundry or at least larger items to wash.

So before a fun quiz to test your laundry skills I will remind you of 2 things...
